PLPOZNANO1:

Services for incoming students:

Orientation Day organized at the beginning of the semesters provides the information about the university in general, administrative issues, student activities, the Polish language course, and other services.

The ESN mentor system (http://uam.esn.pl/) with university guide-person offers the administration and social support and proposes the cultural offer

Foreign students coming to study at AMU within the Erasmus programme can expect:

- assistance from the Erasmus office and programme co-ordinators from the particular faculties
- assistance from Polish students (members of the Erasmus Student Network organization) in handling organizational matters (visit http://www.esn.amu.edu.pl)
- · free courses of Polish Language and culture
- accommodation in the hall of residence (but not earlier then from the last week of September)
- opportunities to participate in cultural events at the University and in Poznań
- opportunities to participate in student get-togethers and sightseeing tours organized by AMU and ESN

Polish courses of language and culture are offered for incoming students in the frame of Summer University programmes as well as regular courses during the semesters (http://www.schoolpl.amu.edu.pl/go.php/en.htm)

Disabled students - the university boasts AMU Association of Disabled Students Ad Astra, founded by students in 2004 to mobilize disabled persons to stand up for their interests and integrate with the whole academic community. University not only brings down structural barriers or offers special stipends to the disabled, but also buys teaching aids in particular for blind and visually impaired students. Since 2005, the contents of the AMU website can be listened to using Intelligent Web Reader application. Disabled students may also take advantage of an individually designed physical-education programme.

For the implementation of STA/STT-mobilities, a letter of invitation – issued by an AMU contact person – is required.

The academic year lasts 9 months, starting on 1st of October and ending in the middle of June. It is divided into two semesters: winter semester (October to January) and summer semester (mid-February to May). A two-week exam session is held at the end of each semester. An inter-semester break lasts from mid-January to mid-February.

There are several vacation breaks: the winter break lasts from 23 December to 1 January and one week in February, the spring break falls at the time of Easter, and the summer break is from mid-June till the end of September. Note: field training exercises and internships may be held during the summer break.

- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination

clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]

The implementation of a credit points framework compatible with that of ECTS allows students to follow individualized curricula and continue their studies at other polish and foreign universities.

- 1 full academic year = 60 credits
- 1 semester = 30 credits
- A/5 EXCELLENT outstanding performance
- B/4+ VERY GOOD above the average standard with only minor errors
- C/4 GOOD generally sound work with some minor errors
- D/3+ SATISFACTORY fair but with a number of notable errors
- E/3 SUFFICIENT fair but with significant shortcomings
- F/2 FAIL
