- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]
- 4. Termination of the agreement

The present Bilateral Agreement will be valid for the academic year(s) mentioned above unless either side terminates the present Agreement in writing by June 1st of the year prior to the academic year concerned. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given.
