It will take place on **November 15–16, 2024** at the Faculty of Philology
at University of Lodz, Łódź, ul. Pomorska 171/173.

We invite students and Ph.D. students interested in the entire Slavic area – meaning Western, Southern and Eastern Slavic areas – to participate. The aim of the event is to enable young researchers to share their scientific interests and research. The international scope of the meeting will make it possible for the participants to exchange experience in a multicultural group and establish new contacts with foreign research centers. The conference is interdisciplinary in nature; speeches may touch on linguistic, literary, cultural, ethnographic or historical topics.

Possible topics for the presentations:

- Slavic diasporas in the world;
- glottodidactics of Slavic languages;
- Slavic dialectology;
- the latest phenomena in Slavic literature;
- Slavic cinematography;
- national/ethnic minorities in the Slavic region;
- the language of communist propaganda in Slavic countries;
- Slavic microlanguages;
- Slavicity in pop culture;
- ethnic conflicts over the centuries;
- revival movements;
- Slavic folklore;

- borderland;
- contemporary social problems in Slavic countries; - customs and customs over the centuries.

The conference will be held on-site; however, it is possible for speakers from abroad to speak online via the MS Teams platform.

The conference languages are all Slavic languages and English.

The speaking time is 20 minutes.

After the conference, it is planned to publish a reviewed multi-author monograph.

Applications for the conference (application form) should be sent by **October 24, 2024**, at 23:59, to **mundus.slavicus@filologia.uni.lodz.pl**.

By October 2 this year, you will have received feedback about getting accepted to the conference.

Participation in the conference and publication are free of charge. Participants cover the costs of transport, accommodation and meals themselves. Light refreshments are planned for the speakers.
